Pályázatot nyújthatnak be az "MTA Kiváló Kutatóhely" minősítéssel rendelkező kutatóintézetek és kutatóközpontok, valamint ilyen minősítéssel rendelkező kutatási egységeik kutató foglalkoztatottjai, vagy egyetemek "MTA Kiváló Kutatóhely" minősítéssel rendelkező kutatási egységeinek kutató foglalkoztatottjai.

A jelen pályázati kiírás keretében az érdeklődő kutatók 2023. szeptember 29-ig nyújthatják be pályázataikat.

EN: The Hungarian Academy of Science (MTA) provides mobility support in the framework of bilateral agreements with partner academies and organisations in 2-3 year projects agreed jointly, within a fixed annual budget. Applications may be submitted by research staff of research institutes and research centres with the "MTA Excellent Research Site" status and research staff of their research units with this status, or by research staff of research units of universities with the "MTA Excellent Research Site" status.

Under this call for proposals, interested researchers may submit their applications until 29 September 2023.

II. Status of Switzerland in Horizon Europe

What is the current association status for Switzerland? How do Swiss applicants apply to Horizon Europe? What are the Swiss transitional measures for Horizon Europe? Swiss entities can participate in most Horizon Europe calls. Funding is provided by the Swiss government as long as Switzerland is not associated to the programme. These questions and more are answered by Euresearch.

III. EU budget: Commission proposes Strategic Technologies for Europe Platform (STEP) to support European leadership on critical technologies

Strengthening the competitiveness of the European economy through the green and digital transformations has been the EU's strategic goal over the last years. The Commission has proposed the Strategic Technologies for Europe Platform ('STEP'). The STEP will reinforce and leverage existing EU instruments to quickly deploy financial support to the benefit of business investments.

The STEP will build on existing programmes such as InvestEU, Innovation Fund, Horizon Europe, EU4Health, Digital Europe Programme, European Defence Fund, Recovery and Resilience Facility, and cohesion policy funds.

To boost the investment capacity dedicated specifically to promoting STEP objectives, the Commission further proposes to allocate additional €10 billion to targeted programmes. Altogether, the total estimated amount of new investments through STEP could reach up to €160 billion.

IV. Virtual Horizon Europe Cluster 5 Info Day

The virtual Info Day for Horizon Europe Cluster 5 - Climate, Energy & Mobility will be held on **17 October 2023**. The Info Day will present the research and innovation topics proposed for 2024 under the Work Programme 2023-2024 of Horizon Europe Cluster 5, addressing Climate, Energy and Mobility. The event will give the opportunity to prospective applicants to learn more about the funding options of the programme for 2024 which focuses on twin green and digital transitions to achieve climate neutrality in Europe by 2050.

80 open topics of the Horizon Europe Cluster 5 calls for 2024 will be presented by way of a plenary and four parallel sessions. For a detailed agenda, more information on how to participate and other practical details, visit the <u>event</u> website.

VI. New SESAR calls for proposals launched

The SESAR 3 Joint Undertaking (SESAR 3 JU) has published the second open call addressing exploratory research within the framework of its Digital European Sky research and innovation programme. The call covers a wide range of topics aimed at generating innovative concepts, methodologies and technologies to support the delivery of a Digital European Sky. The selected projects will be funded within the framework of the EU's Horizon Europe research and innovation programme (Total budget: EUR 25 million).

VII. EARMA grants and opportunities

- Virtual Event Grant (VEG) 2023: Since its launch in 2020 during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Virtual Event Grant (VEG) has been a catalyst for innovation and creativity in planning and executing virtual events. EARMA allocated a total of €1,000 to support either a collaborative event by a small group of institutions or two separate events hosted by individual institutions. They also welcome applications for smaller amounts, as this allows for the potential funding of more projects. The grant funding can be used for various purposes, including the design, promotion, and delivery of the virtual event, as well as fees for external speakers. Read more and apply. Deadline is July 10, 2023.
- Invited Speaker Award 2023: EARMA Invited Speaker Award 2023 aims to enrich events with distinguished speakers, whether virtual or in-person. EARMA will provide funding of up to €500 per event to facilitate the engagement of esteemed external speakers. This funding can be utilised for securing speakers, designing and producing digital content, and covering modest costs related to equipment or supporting materials. Read more and apply. - EARMA Leadership Event 2023: Managers and leaders from research, grants, or sponsored programme offices at research organisations are invited to participate in the EARMA Leadership Event 2023. With this Leadership event, EARMA offers a tailor-made program that will target some of these issues, through keynote presentations as well as working and sharing in peer learning groups. This event takes place November 22 24, 2023, in-person in Brussels. Register.
