The following challenges faced by both scientists and citizens will be addressed:

- Participation and motivation: What are the main reasons for scientists to engage with citizens and for citizens to engage in science? How do participants benefit from their experience? What are the key obstacles for widening participation?
- Strategies for engagement: What are the best ways to attract and sustain participation over time? How can communities of practice that encourage engagement and learning be created? What is the best way to combine physical and online tools/techniques?
- Quality and impact: What type of knowledge can be generated and according to which standards? Is engagement with citizens a way to enhance the quality of science, or only to enhance science impact in the wider society? What is the concrete impact on scientific practices and everyday lives of citizens? What are the key enablers for citizen science?

VII. New call launched for SESAR 3 JU Digital Sky Demonstrators

The [European Climate, Infrastructure and Environment Executive Agency](https://www.cinea.eu) (CINEA) has launched a new call under the Connecting Europe Facility, containing provisions for a series of SESAR JU Digital European Sky Demonstrators in the areas of automation and virtualisation. The demonstrators are a key tool to support the SESAR JU's vision of delivering the Digital European Sky, matching the ambitions of "sustainable and smart mobility" and "Europe fit for the digital age" initiatives. The demonstrators, when selected, are expected to be launched in 2023 and to run until 2026.

The Digital Sky Demonstrators will take place in live operational environments and will put to the test (on a very large scale) the technological solutions necessary to deliver the Digital European Sky. The demonstrators are part of an innovation pipeline designed by the SESAR Joint 3 Undertaking to bridge the gap between applied/industrial research and industrialisation, and to accelerate market uptake.

CEF SESAR 3 JU call topics

- **Gradual transition to higher levels of automation** (CEF-T-2022-SIMOBGEN-SESAR-DSDA-WORKS): Europe's ATM infrastructure operates with low levels of automation support and data exchange, leading to rigidity, lack of scalability and resilience, and an inability to exploit emerging digital technologies, including in support of new airspace users. The future architecture of the European sky requires increased automation in air traffic control and an infrastructure commensurate with the performance required by each airspace user type and environment, including those in the transition areas between Europe and neighbouring ICAO regions, which may have specific regulations and challenges.
- **Virtual centres and ATM data service providers (ADSPs)** (CEF-T-2022-SIMOBGEN-SESAR-DSDU-WORKS): A lack of flexibility in the sector configuration capabilities at pan-European level. This is caused by the close coupling of ATM service provision to the ATS systems and operational procedures, preventing air traffic from making use of cloud-based data service provision. A more flexible use of external data services, considering data properties and access rights, would allow the infrastructure to be rationalised, reducing the related costs. It will enable data-sharing, foster a more dynamic airspace management and ATM service

provision, allowing air traffic service units (ATSU) to improve capacity in portions of airspace where traffic demand exceeds the available capacity. It furthermore offers options for the contingency of operations and the resilience of ATM service provision.

The deadline for submissions is 18 January 2023.

The SESAR 3 Joint Undertaking, with the support of the European Climate, Infrastructure and Environment Executive Agency (CINEA), is organising **an information session on 25 November** to provide guidance on preparing proposals for SESAR-related topics contained in the recently launched call under the Connecting Europe Facility.

The two SESAR-related topics covered by the call, “gradual transition towards higher levels of automation” and “virtual centres and ATM data service providers (ADSPs)”, have been selected from among nine flagships outlined in SESAR 3 Joint undertaking’s [multiannual work programme](#).

The online session will present guidance, as well as best practices, on completing proposals.

VIII. Accelerating Agroecology Transition: Your potential role and benefits of contributing to a European network of Living Labs and Research Infrastructures - ALL-READY workshop

The European Partnership under Horizon Europe for Accelerating Farming Systems Transition by Agroecology Living Labs and Research Infrastructures is currently being prepared by the SCAR Agroecology Strategic Working Group. ALL-Ready is a Coordination and Support Action (CSA) funded by the European Commission with the aim of preparing a framework for a future European network of Living Labs and Research Infrastructures that will enable the transition towards agroecology throughout Europe. It will provide spaces for long-term, site-specific, multi-stakeholder and real-life experimentation, and direction for research activities on agroecology at the European and national levels.
